

Train To Move (T2M):

a transnational mobility fellowship programme

We are glad to inform you that the University of Turin, with the support of the European Commission and the banking foundation Compagnia di San Paolo under FP7-PEOPLE-2013-COFUND Action, is going to launch the 2nd Call of *2020 RESEARCHERS: TRAIN TO MOVE (T2M) programme.*

- The 1st call for proposals received a high interest with a total of 170 applications, and it granted 14 fellows who are going to start their fellowships at university departments in the next months.
- With the 2nd Call, T2M programme intends to offer *14 more grants* to*high skilled researchers*, giving them the opportunity to carry out *a research project at one of 26 hosting departments of the

University* and to attend a *unique training on soft skills*.

The T2M experience will contribute to the development of *personal transferable skills* of awarded fellows and will train them for developing careers in *academic and non-academic sectors*.

T2M programme is open to researchers of any nationality, in possession of MSc degree, that at the time of the call deadline, are either in possession of a PhD from no more than 7 years or demonstrate to have, in the last ten years, a track record of at least 4 consecutive years of full time equivalent research experience up to 10 years.

*Moreover eligible researchers need to comply with the mobility rule, that is they must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Italy for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the closing date for submitting proposals. *

The *2nd T2M call for proposals* is now open. Deadline for submission is the *5^th of May 2015.*
